## *Possessive Pronouns*

**i** = his, hers, theirs, its -nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.

**im** = his, hers, theirs, its -m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

**Katos vt im oka ishko.**

The cat is drinking her water.

**Im ilefoka yvt holitopa.**

His/Her clothes are expensive.

Word Meaning:

**im** (ehm) = his, hers, theirs, its      **vt** (aht) = subject marker

**oka** (o-ka) = water      **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**ishko** (esh-ko) = drinks/ing      **ilefoka** (e-le-fo-ka) = clothes

**holitopa** (ho-lee-to-pa) = expensive, costly      **katos** (ka-tos) = cat

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
