Possessive Pronouns

a = my -nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.
vm = my -m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

Svshki yvt hoponi imponna.

My mother is an expert cook.

Svshki yvt a hullo fehna.

My mother loves me very much.

Word Meaning:

svshki (sash-ki) = my mother **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

imponna (im-pon-na) = expert; to know how; skillful

a hullo (ahn hul-lo) = to love me **fehna** (feh-na) = very

hoponi (ho-po-ni) = to cook

Base words for kinship terms:

hvshki = mother **nakfi** = brother **pokni** = grandmother

iki = father **i tek** = sister **mafo** = grandfather

a hullo = to love me **i hullo** = to love him, her **chi hullo** = to love you

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
