Vocabulary: **haksobali** – to make noise, make a racket, be noisy, loud

Virginia vt haksobali na i nukoa li tuk.

I was mad at Virginia because she was noisy.

Iti isht bvshli mvt haksobali.

That chainsaw is loud.

Word Meaning:

vt (aht) = subject marker

haksobali (hahk-soh-bah-lih) = to make noise, make a racket, be noisy, loud

na (nah) = because

i (ehn) = him, her, it

nukoa (noh-koh-wah) = mad, angry

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

iti isht bvshli (ih-tih esht bahsh-lih) = chainsaw

mvt (maht) = that
