Vocabulary: **umo** – to harvest, pick (berries, etc.), to mow

**Pokni yvt bissa umo kv̄t im achukma.**

Grandma enjoys picking blackberries.

**Michael vt hashuk umo chi.**

Michael will mow the lawn.

## Word Meaning:

**pokni** (pohk-nih) = grandmother

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**bissa** (bihs-sah) = berries

**umo** (ah-moh) = to harvest, pick (berries, etc.), to mow

**kv̄t** (kaht) = conjunction used when speaking of same subject

**im achukma** (ehm ah-chohk-mah) = to like to do something

**vt** (aht) = subject marker

**hashuk** (hah-shohk) = grass

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker

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
