Vocabulary: **ish - you**

Chishno ak bano hosh ish ia chi ho?

Are you going by yourself?

Con conversationally spoken:

Chishnak bano hosh ish ia chi ho?

Katimma ish aya?

Where are you?

Word Meaning: **hosh** (hohsh) = adverb

chishno ak bano (chihsh-noh ahk bah-noh) = you alone

ish (esh) = you **ia** (e-yah) = you

chi (chehn) = future tense marker

ho (hohn) = question marker

katimma (kah-tihm-mah) = where

aya (ahn-yah) = go; going – to be in motion
