Vocabulary: **oka** – water (1 of 5)

Luak ma oka ofohobli.

Pour water onto the fire.

Yakah! Itipatalhpo ya oka hlatabli li.

Oh my! I spilled water on the floor.

Word Meaning: li (lih) = I

oka (o-kah) = water

luak (loh-wahk) = fire

ma (mah) = object marker

ofohobli (ohn-foh-hohb-lih) = pour onto

yakah (yah-kah) = oh my

itipatalhpo (ih-tih-pah-tahth-poh) = floor

ya (yahn) = subject marker

hlatabli (thah-tahb-lih) = spilled
