Vocabulary: **oka** – water (3 of 5)

**Ulla yvt oka isht washoha hosh maya.**

The children are playing with the water.

**Oka vllhto ma akka talali.**

Set the water container down.

**Word Meaning:**

**vlla** (ahl-lah) = child

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**oka** (o-kah) = water

**isht** (esht) = with

**washoha** (wah-shoh-ha) = play

**hosh** (hohsh) = adverb marker

**maya** (mahn-yah) = 2 or more to exist/be there

**vllhto** (ahth-toh) = container

**ma** (mah) = object marker

**akka** (ahk-kah) = down

**talali** (tah-lah-lih) = to set/place
