Vocabulary: **tiwa** – to become open (1 of 3)

Katimmikma aiittvtoba mvt tiwa chi?

When (in the future) will that store open?

Okhisa yvt tiwa chi.

The door is going to open.

Word Meaning:

katimmikma (kah-tihm-mihk-ma) = when (in the future)

aiittvtoba (eye-iht-tah-toh-bah) = store

mvt (maht) = that

tiwa (tih-wah) = to become open

chi (chehn) = future tense marker (short form of achi)

okhisa (ohk-hih-sah) = door

yvt (yaht) = subject marker
