Vocabulary: **tiwa** – to already be “in the state of being” open (2 of 3)

Okhissushi yvt tiwa.

The window is open.

Himonasi ya aiittvtoba mvt tiwa.

The store is open right now.

Word Meaning:

okhissushi (ohk-hihs-soh-she) = window

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

tiwa (tih-n-wah) = to already be open

himonasi ya (hih-moh-nah-sih yahn) = right now

aiittvtoba (eye-iht-tah-toh-bah) = store

mvt (maht) = the
