Vocabulary: **vlhkuma** – closed; shut (2 of 2)

Wal-Mart vt oppiakma/obbiakma/okkiakma vlhkuma chi.

Wal-Mart will close this evening.

Okhisa yvt chitoli hosh vlhkuma tuk.

The door slammed shut.

Word Meaning: okhisa (ohk-hih-sah) = door

oppiakma (ohp-peyahk-mah) = evening

obbiakma (ohb-beyahk-mah) = evening

okkiakma (ohk-kiahk-mah) = evening

vlhkuma (ahth-kah-mah) = closed; shut

chi (chehn) = future tense marker

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

vt (aht) = subject marker

chitoli (che-toh-lih) = to be loud

hosh (hohsh) = adverb marker **tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

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
