Pronouns: **e/il** - we

E kania tuk.

We left.

Il ia chi.

We are going.

Word Meaning:

e (eh) = we

kania (kah-nih-yah) = go away/to be gone

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

il (ill) = we

ia (e-yah) = go/going

chi (chehn) = future tense marker
