Pronoun: **they** (unmarked)

Okla okhvta ilhkoli.

They are going to the lake.

Nvni lawa hokli tuk.

They caught a lot of fish.

Word Meaning:

nvni (na-nih) = fish

lawa (lahn-wah) = plural for many, a lot of, several

hokli (hohk-lih) = catch

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

okhvta (ohk-hah-tah) = lake

ilhkoli (eth-koh-lih) = go/going (plural)

okla (ohk-la) = they, plural; group, people, etc.
