**Chim vlla yvt pim ofi aiokpanchi.**

Your child likes our dog.

**Word Meaning:** **issuba** (es-soh-bah) = horse

**pim** (pehm) = our      **vlla** (ahl-la) = child

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**ombinili** (ohm-bih-nih-lih) = to ride/to sit on

**bvnna** (bahn-nah) = want/need

**aiokpanchi** (eye-yohk-pahn-chih) = like (something)

**chim** (chehm) = your

**ofi** (o-fih) = dog

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
