Possessive Pronoun: **h̄vchi** – your (all)

H̄vchi chukka yvt tohbi yo?

Is your house white?

Ilvppvt h̄vchi chukka yo?

Is this your house?

Word Meaning:

h̄vchi (hah-chehn) = your (all)

chukka (chohk-ka) = house

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

tohbi (yoh-bih) = white

yo (yohn) = question marker

ilvppvt (i-lahp-paht) = subject marker (this/these)
