Possessive Pronouns: **chi/chim** - your

chi = your -nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.

chim = your -m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

Chim illimpa vpa!

Eat your food!

Chim okhissa tiwwi!

Open your door!

Word Meaning:

chim (chehm) = your

illimpa (ihl-lehm-pa) = food

vpa (ah-pa) = to eat

okhissa (ohk-his-sah) = door

tiwwi (tih-wih) = to open
