

# Lesson of The Day

## Possessive Pronoun: **i** & **im**

**i** = his, hers, theirs, its –nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.

**im** = his, hers, theirs, its –m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

**i chukka yvt bilika.**

His/Her house is near(by).

**i wak ipeta tuk.**

He/She fed his cows.

### Word Meaning:

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**wak** (wahk) = cow

**im** (ehm) = his, hers, theirs, its – before words beginning with a vowel

**i** (ehn) = his, hers, theirs, its – before words beginning with a consonant

**chukka** (chohk-ka) = house

**bilika** (bi-lehn-ka) = near(by)

**ipeta** (ih-pe-ta) = feed

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

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
