Body parts 'nashuka' & 'sv'

'**Sv**' is a possessive personal pronoun that is used when one is referring to emotions, some family relationships and body parts. It can be translated as '**my**' and also '**I am**' when describing emotions or state of mind.

Sv nashuka yvt chito.

My face is big.

Chi nashuka yvt homma.

Your face is red.

Word Meaning:

sv (sah) = my **homma** (hom-ma) = red **chi** (che) = your

nashuka (na-shu-ka) = face **chito** (chi-to) = big

yvt (yaht) = subject marker
