Weather Sentences - Lesson 3 of 4

Kucha yvt kapussachih* chohmi.

It's sort of cold outside.

Kucha yvt libeshah* chohmi.

It's kind of warm outside.

*a predicative 'h' is added to verbs when they are followed by certain adverbs

Word Meaning:

kucha (koh-cha) = outside

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

kapussachih (kah-pahs-sah-che) = cool

libeshah (le-be-sha) = warm

chohmi (choh-meh) = sort of/ kind of/ somewhat
