Weather Sentences – Lesson 4 of 4

Kucha yvt oktushah* chiyyohmi.

It's really snowing outside.

Kucha yvt malvhtah* chiyyohmi.

It's really lightning outside.

*a predicative 'h' is added to verbs when they are followed by certain adverbs

Word Meaning: **kucha** (koh-cha) = outside

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

oktushah (ohk-toh-shah) = snow/ snowing

malvhtah (ma- lah-tah) = lightning

chiyyohmi (che-yoh-meh) = very (emphatic/ really/ quite
