Atek tuklo yvt tumaha vshwa.

My two sisters live in town.

Word Meaning: **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

chukka (chohk-kah) = house

sipokni (see-pohk-nih) = old

il (ihl) = we **tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two

vshwa (ahsh-wah) = to be (exist/reside/live) = dual

atek (ahn-tek) = my sister

tumaha (tah-ma-ha) = town
