Dialogue Lesson 2 of 3: **Aiittv̄toba ish ia ch̄i h̄o?**

A previous lesson asked “**Aiittv̄toba ish ia ch̄i h̄o?**” (Will you be going to the store?) This lesson answers that question.

Ch̄ih* kasha.

Probably will.

*a predicative ‘h’ is added to verbs when they are followed by certain adverbs

The full meaning of this expression is: **Yohma ch̄ih kasha.**

It will probably be so (in that manner).

Word Meaning:

ch̄i (ch^{enh}) = future tense (from **achi**)

kasha (k^{ahn}-sha) = probably, likely to happen

Note: underlined vowels are nasalized
