Dialogue Lesson 3 of 3: **Nanta ish chompa chi?**

Nanta ish chompa chi?

(the 'a' in 'chompa' is dropped and the 'a' in 'achi' replaces it:

chompa achi → chompa chi)

What will you buy?

Isht washoha chompa la chi.

('li' changes to 'la' for the future tense marker 'achi')

I will buy toys.

Na halbena chompa la chi.

I will buy gifts.

Word Meaning: **nanta** (nahn-tah) = what

ish (esh) = you, precedes verbs **chompa** (chohm-pah) = buy

li (le) = I, follows a verb **achi** (ah-ch^{ehn}) = will/ shall

isht washoha (esht wah-shoh-ha) = toy

na halbena (nah hahl-bih-na) = gift
