Vocabulary: **pṽchi - pigeon**

Pṽchi pisa hosh hikia li.

I am standing here looking at the pigeons.

Pṽchi ṽt oka ishko.

The pigeon is drinking water.

Word Meaning:

pṽchi (pah-che) = pigeon

pisa (pih-sah) = look

hosh (hohsh) = adverb marker

hikia (he-kihn-yah) = stand

li (lih) = I

ṽt (aht) = subject marker

oka (o-kah) = water

ishko (esh-koh) = drink
