Vocabulary: **anusi shukcha** – sleeping bag

Anusi shukcha himona chompa bvnna.

He wants to buy a new sleeping bag.

Chim vlla yvt anusi shukcha anuka ma nusi hosh ittonla.

Your child is asleep inside that sleeping bag.

Word Meaning: **bvnna** (bahn-nah) = want

anusi shukcha (ah-noh-sih shohk-chah) = sleeping bag

himona (hih-moh-nah) = new

chompa (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase

chim (chehm) = your

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

anuka (ah-noh-kah) = inside

ma (mahn) = that

nusi (noh-sih) = sleep

hosh (hohsh) = adverb marker

ittonla (iht-tohn-lah) = to be lying
