

# Lesson of The Day

Indirect Object: chim – to or for you

**Ilefoka chim acheda tuk.**

She washed clothes for you?

**Chim apoksia chi ho?**

Will he fix it for you?

Word Meaning:

**ilefoka** (e-lih-foh-ka) = clothes

**chim** (chehm) = to or for you

**acheda** (ah-che-fah) = wash

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**apoksia** (ah-pohk-se-ah) = to repair/to fix

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker (from **achi**)

**ho** (hohn) = question marker

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
