Dialogue Lesson 3 of 3: **Kucha yvt pisa katiohmi?**

Question: Kucha yvt pisa katiohmi?

What is the weather like?

Answer: Himak nittak vt hoshonti.

It is cloudy today.

Or

Omba chi ahoba.

It looks like it will rain.

Word Meaning: kucha (koh-cha) = outside (weather)

omba (ohm-bah) = rain **hoshonti** (hoh-shohn-te) = cloudy

himak nittak (he-mahk ne-tahk) = today

vt (aht)/ **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

pisa (pi-sa) = look **katiohmi** (kah-te-oh-mih) = how

chi (ch^{ehn}) = future tense marker (from **achi**)

ahoba (ah-ho-bah) = appear/ seem
