Indirect Object: the nasal form - a/sa - to or for me

Na pakanli a hokchi tuk.

He planted flowers for me.

Nanta ish sa chompa tuk?

What did you buy for me?

Word Meaning:

na pakanli (nah pah-kahn-lih) = flower/flowers

a (ahn) = to or for me **sa** (sahn) = to or for me

hokchi (hohk-che) = to plant

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

nanta (nahn-tah) = what **ish** (esh) = you

chompa (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase

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
