Indirect Object: nasal form p̄i – to or for us

Ūlla m̄vt p̄i taloa ch̄i.

That child will sing for us.

S̄ushki ȳvt p̄i ho^oponi.

My mother is cooking for us.

Word Meaning:

Ūlla (ahl-la) = child

m̄vt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

p̄i (pehn) = to or for us **taloa** (tah-loh-wah) = sing

ch̄i (chehn) = future tense marker (from **achi**)

s̄ushki (sahsh-ke) = my mother

ȳvt (yaht) = subject marker

ho^oponi (hoh-poh-nih) = cook
