Possessive Adjective: chimmi – yours/belongs to you

Shapo pvt chimmi yo?

Is that hat yours?

Ampo pvt chimmi.

This plate is yours.

Word Meaning:

shapo (shah-poh) = hat

pvt (paht) = this/these

chimmi (chehm-mih) = yours/belongs to you

yo (yohn) = question marker

ampo (ahm-poh) = plate/dish
