

Lesson of The Day

Location/Position: *chiya* – to be sitting (dual)

Mafo micha pokni yvt kucha chiya.

Grandpa and grandma are sitting outside.

Katos tuklo mvt kaa pakna chiya.

Those two cats are sitting on top of the car.

Word Meaning: **mafo** (mah-foh) = grandfather

micha (me-chah) = and **pokni** (pohk-nih) = grandmother

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **katos** (kah-tohs) = cat

kucha (koh-chah) = outside

chiya (chehn-yah) = to be sitting

tuklo (tohk-loh) = two **kaa** (kah) = car

mvt (maht) = those

pakna (pahk-na) = on top of
