

Lesson of The Day

Verb: *achefa* – to wash

Ohoyo mvt ampo achefa.

That woman is washing the dishes.

Ilefoka achefa li.

I am washing clothes.

Word Meaning:

ohoyo (oo-hoh-yoh) = woman

mvt (maht) = subject marker (that)

ampo (ahm-poh) = plate/dish

achefa (ah-che-fa) = to wash

ilefoka (ih-le-fohk-ka) = clothes

li (lih) = I
