Verb: **achefa** – to wash (something)

Ilefoka achefa li.

I am washing clothes.

Ilefoka liteha achefa li.

I am washing dirty clothes.

Word Meaning:

ilefoka (ih-le-fohk-ka) = clothes

liteha (lih-te-ha) = dirty

achefa (ah-che-fa) = to wash

li (lih) = I, follows verbs
