Dialogue and Response

Question: **Chi na yukpa ho?**
Are you happy?

Answer: **Sv na yukpa.**
I am happy.
Or
Sv na yukpa ahli.
I am truly happy.

'**Sv**' is a possessive personal pronoun used when referring to emotions, some family relationships, and body parts. It can be translated as '**my**' and '**I am**' when describing emotions or state of mind.

Word Meaning: **chi** (che) = to or for you

na yukpa (nah yohk-pah) = happy

sv (sah) = I am/ my

ahli (a^{hn}-theh) = truly

ho (h^{ohn}) = question marker
