

Lesson of The Day

Indirect Object: i and im - to or for them/it

im - m form, prefixed before words that begin with *vowels*

i - nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with *consonants*

I toksvli la chi.

I will be working for them.

I nukoa ho?

Is he mad at them?

Word Meaning:

i (e^{hn}) = to or for them

toksvli (tohk-sah-lih) = work

la (lih) = I (Changes to 'la' for future tense ending)

chi (ch^{ehn}) = future tense marker (from **achi**)

nukoa (noh-koh-wah) = mad/angry

ho (hohn) = question marker
