Dialogue Lesson 2 of 4: **Impa chi bunnā hō?**

A previous lesson asked “**Impa chi bunnā hō?**” (Do you want to eat?) This Lesson answers that question.

A, impa sū bunnā.

Yes, I want to eat.

Word Meaning: **a** (a^{hn}) = yes

impa (ehm-pa) = eat, to eat

sū (che) = you

bunnā (bahn-nah) = want/ need

‘**Sū**’ is a possessive personal pronoun used when referring to emotions, some family relationships, and body parts. It can be translated as ‘**my**’ and ‘**I am**’ when describing emotions or state of mind.

The next lesson will also answer “**Impa chi bunnā hō?**” (Do you want to eat?)
