Vocabulary: **yopisa** – spectator/sightseer

Towa washoha ya yopisa yvt lawa tuk.

There were a lot of spectators at the ballgame.

Hattak mvt yopisa yo?

Is that man a sightseer?

Word Meaning: mvt (maht) = that

towa washoha (toh-wah wah-shoh-ha) = ball game

ya (yahn) = subject marker

yopisa (yoh-pih-sah) = spectator/sightseer

yvt (yaht) = object marker

lawa (lah-wah) = a lot

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

yo (yohn) = question marker

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
