Pronoun: kanimma kia - anywhere

Pinak ma ahoponi kanimma kia ashachi.

Put the groceries anywhere in the kitchen.

Kanimma kia ia chi bunna ho?

Do you want to go anywhere?

Word Meaning: **pinak** (pih-nahk) = food/groceries

ma (mahn) = object marker **chi** (che) = you

ahoponi (ah-hoh-poh-nih) = kitchen

kanimma kia (ka-nim-mah-ke-yah) anywhere

ashachi (ah-sha-che) = put/place/lay (pl)

ia (e-yah) = go/going **ho** (hohn) = question marker

bunna (bahn-nah) = want/need
