Adverbs/ Adjectives of Degree: **chohmi**, **chiyyohmi**, **fehna**

Kucha yvt kapvssah* chohmi.

It is sort of cold outside.

Kucha yvt kapvssah* fehna.

It is very cold outside.

Kucha yvt kapvssah* chiyyohmi!

It is really cold outside!

*a predicative 'h' is added to verbs when they are followed by certain adverbs

Word Meaning: **kucha** (koh-cha) = outside

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

kapvssa (kah-pahs-sah) = cold

chohmi (choh-meh) = sort of/ kind of/ somewhat

chiyyohmi (che-yoh-meh) = very (emphatic)/ really/ quite

fehna (feh-nah) = very
