Dialogue Lesson 2 of 5: **Chi hochowa ho?**

A previous lesson asked “**Chi hochowa ho?**” (Are you cold?) This lesson answers that question.

A, sv hochowa.

Yes, I am cold.

‘**Sv**’ is a possessive personal pronoun used when referring to emotions, some family relationships, and body parts. It can be translated as ‘**my**’ and ‘**I am**’ when describing emotions or state of mind.

Word Meaning:

a (a^{hn}) = yes

sv (sah) = I am

hochowa (ho-cho-wa) = cold (body temperature)
