Dialogue Lesson 1 of 3: **Tumaha ish ia chi ho?**

Tumaha ish ia chi ho?

Will you be going to town?

Note: underlined vowels are nasalized

Word Meaning: **tumaha** (tah-ma-ha) = town

ish (esh) = you **ia** (e-ya) = to go

chi (ch^{ehn}) = future tense (from **achi**)

ho (h^{ohn}) = question marker

Question markers are placed at the end of a question.

Question Marker Rules

1. **o** – follows a word that ends in a consonant
2. **ho** – follows a verb
3. **yo** – follows descriptive words (adjectives, numbers, etc.)
