Dialogue Lesson 3 of 3: **Tumaha ish ia chi ho?**

A previous lesson asked “**Tumaha ish ia chi ho?**” (Will you be going to town?) This lesson answers that question.

Question markers are placed at the end of the question.

Question Marker Rules

1. **o** – follows a word that ends in a consonant
2. **ho** – follows a verb
3. **yo** – follows descriptive words (adjectives, numbers, etc.)

***Keyuh kasha**.

Probably not.

*a predicative ‘h’ is added to verbs when they are followed by certain adverbs

Word Meaning:

chi (ch^{ehn}) = future tense (from **achi**)

kasha (k^{ahn}-sha) = probably, likely to happen

Note: underlined vowels are nasalized
