Dialogue Lesson 3 of 4: **Impa chi bunnna ho?**

A previous lesson asked “**Impa chi bunnna ho?**” (Do you want to eat?) This Lesson answers that question.

Keyu, impa sv bunnna kiyo.

No, I don't want to eat.

Word Meaning: **keyu** (key-yoh) = no

impa (ehm-pa) = eat, to eat

sv (sah) = I **bunnna** (bahn-nah) = want/ need

kiyo (key-yoh) = not

‘**Sv**’ is a possessive personal pronoun used when referring to emotions, some family relationships, and body parts. It can be translated as ‘**my**’ and ‘**I am**’ when describing emotions or state of mind.
