Dialogue Lesson 4 of 4: **Impa chi bvnna ho?**

A previous lesson asked “**Impa chi bvnna ho?**” (Do you want to eat?) This Lesson answers that question.

Impa sv bvnna bilia.

I always want to eat.

Word Meaning:

impa (ehm-pa) = eat, to eat

sv (sah) = I **bvnna** (bahn-nah) = want/ need

bilia (bi-le-ya) = always

‘**Sv**’ is a possessive personal pronoun used when referring to emotions, some family relationships, and body parts. It can be translated as ‘**my**’ and ‘**I am**’ when describing emotions or state of mind.
