Verb: kashoffi – to clean

Chim aboha ish kashoffi tuk o?

Did you clean your room?

Himak nittak a chim aboha ish kashoffi tuk o?

Did you clean your room today?

Word Meaning: **a** (a^{hn}) = object marker

himak nittak (he-mahk ne-tahk) = today

chim aboha (chehm ah-boh-ha) = your room

ish (esh) = you, used after action words

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fih) = to clean

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

o (o^{hn}) = question marker

Note: underlined vowels are nasalized
