Conjunction: micha/ cha – and

Ulla mvt im aboha kashoffi cha yupi tuk.

That child cleaned his room and bathed.

Ampo micha isht ishko ish kashoffi tuk o?

Did you clean the plates and glasses?

Word Meaning: **vlla** (ahl-lah) = child

ampo (ahm-poh) = plate/ dish

isht ishko (esht ish-ko) = cup/ glass

im aboha (ehm ah-boh-ha) = his room

mvt (maht) = that/ those **ish** (esh) = you

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fih) = to clean

yupi (yoh-pih) = to bathe

micha (mih-chah)/ **cha** (chah) = and

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

o (o^{hn}) = question marker
