Verb: kashoffi – to clean

Okhisushi kashoffi li.

I am cleaning the windows.

Ahoponi ya kashoffi li tuk.

I cleaned the kitchen.

Word Meaning:

ya (y^{ahn}) = object marker

ahoponi (ah-hoh-poh-nih) = kitchen/ stove

ohkisushi (ohk-ih-soh-she) = window

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fih) = to clean

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

li (lih) = I, used after verbs or action words
