Location/Position: takanli – to be hanging (singular)

**Shupo tohbi yvt katimma takanli?**

Where is the white hat hanging?

**Shupo tohbi mvt chim aboha takanli.**

That white hat is hanging in your room.

Word Meaning:

**shupo** (shah-poh) = hat      **tohbi** (toh-bih) = white

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker      **chim** (chehm) = your

**katimma** (kah-tim-ma) = where

**takanli** (tah-kahn-lih) = to be hanging (singular)

**mvt** (maht) = subject marker (that/those)

**aboha** (ah-boh-ha) = room
