## Word Meaning:

shvpo (shah-poh) = hat tohbi (toh-bih) = white
yvt (yaht) = subject marker chim (chehm) = your
katimma (kah-tim-ma) = where
takanli (tah-kahn-lih) = to be hanging (singular)
mvt (maht) = subject marker (that/those)
aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room
```
