What are you thinking about?

Kaa himona chompa sv bunna hosh anukfilli li.

I am thinking about buying a new car.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

ish (esh) = you

anukfilli (ah-nohk-fihl-lih) = to think, reflect, meditate

kaa (kah) = car

himona (hih-moh-nah) = new

chompa (chohm-pah) = to buy/purchase

sv (sah) = I

bunna (bahn-nah) = want

hosh (hohsh) = subject/adverb marker
