Kvta ish i yimmi?

Who do you believe?

Mak sv yimmi. or **Mako sv yimmi.**

That's what I believe.

Word Meaning:

kvta (kah-tah) = who

sv (sah) = I

ish (esh) = you

i (e^{hn}) = to or for him/her/it

yimmi (yihm-mih) = to believe

mak (mahk)/ **mako** (mah-k^{ohn}) = that
